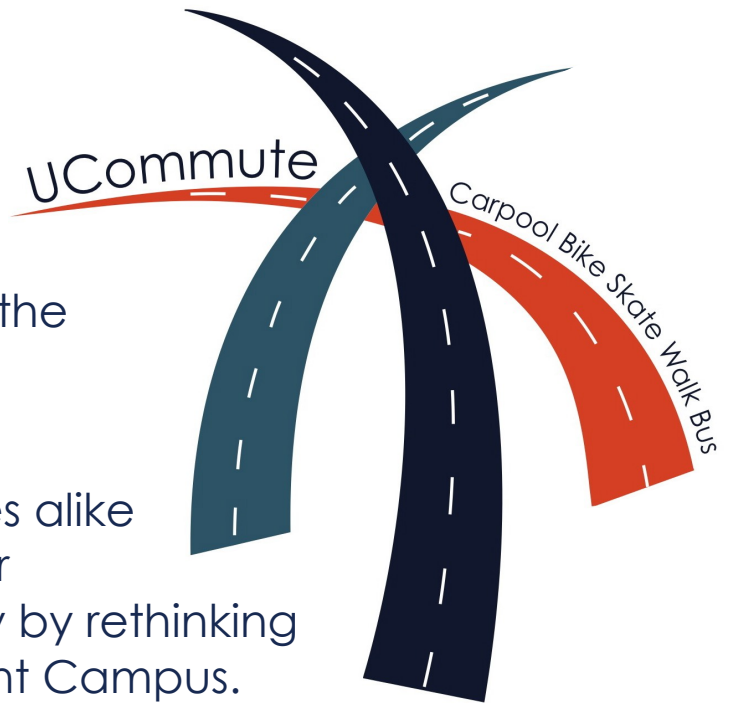


Welcome to MyCommute.org
